### Blankets for Canada – Norfolk County

Trinity Anglican Church Prayer Shawl Ministry is partnering with Blankets for Canada to provide handmade blankets for those in need of warmth within our local community. Blankets may be knit, crocheted, or quilted, following size guidelines provided by Blankets for Canada.



#### BLANKET DIMENSIONS

- 6-inch squares: 8 across for 48 inches and 12 down for 72 inches (96 in a bundle)
  - 7-inch squares: 7 across for 49 inches and 10 down for 70 inches (70 in a bundle)
  - 8-inch squares: 7 across for 56 inches and 9 down for 72 inches (63 in a bundle)
  - 9-inch squares: 6 across for 54 inches and 8 down for 72 inches (48 in a bundle)
  - 10-inch squares: 5 across for 50 inches and 7 down for 70 inches (35 in a bundle)
  - 11-inch squares: 5 across for 55 inches and 7 down for 77 inches (35 in a bundle)

- 5-inch by 7-inch rectangles: 7 across lying sideways for 49 inches and 14 down in a brick wall pattern for 70 inches (98 in a bundle)
  - 6-inch by 8-inch rectangles: 6 across lying sideways for 48 inches and 12 down in a brick wall pattern for 72 inches (72 in a bundle)
  - 7-inch by 8-inch rectangles: 7 across lying lengthways for 49 inches and 9 down on end for 72 inches (63 in a bundle)
  - 9-inch by 8-inch rectangles: 6 across lying sideways for 54 inches and 9 down in a brick wall pattern for 72 inches (54 in a bundle)



*I have a public confession to make.....*

*“I am an unbeliever.*

*I am an unbeliever in a God who lives somewhere “out there”, hovering above the universe like a divine landlord—watching, judging, intervening when it suits him.*

*I am an unbeliever in a God wrapped up in maleness, whose image props up patriarchy and calls domination “divine order”.*

*I am an unbeliever in a God who tortures people forever for getting theology wrong and then calls it justice.*

*I am an unbeliever in a God who rigs the game from the beginning—baiting the first humans into failure and blaming all of humanity for it.*

*I am an unbeliever in a God who engineers a fallen world and then demands blood—his own son’s blood—to clean up a mess he designed.”*

*I am a unbeliever in a God who puts conditions on love, qualifiers on grace, and fine print on acceptance.*

*Yes I am an unbeliever in ‘that God’. And here’s the thing—we made that God up.*

*That God looks suspiciously like our fears, our power structures, our need for control—projected into the sky and baptized as truth.*

*Jesus didn’t believe in that God either.*

*Jesus didn’t teach a distant, punitive, blood-thirsty deity obsessed with belief systems and moral score-keeping. He spoke of a God discovered within, among, and between us—a God of radical inclusion, boundary breaking love, and relentless compassion.*

*The tragedy isn’t unbelief.*

*The tragedy is clinging to a God Jesus himself was trying to dismantle.”*
